II. Testing

Four STANAG 6001 testing cycles were conducted (September 2009, December 2009, March 2010 and June 2010). Internal workshops for introduction of STANAG (Ed.3) were organised with the aim of introducing + levels in official documents and marking. New tasks for all tests in all four skills were written, moderated and piloted. Three new sets of Reading and Listening tasks were written, moderated and piloted.
