1. General English Language Courses		157
1.1	Elementary English (SLP 1110) This 300-hour non-intensive course aimed at providing training in elementary listening, speaking, reading and writing skills. The materials used included Straightforward (elementary) supplemented with selected units from Campaign 1.	67
1.2	Intermediate English (SLP 2221) Course This 300-hour intensive course aimed at providing training in all four skills. It was based on Straightforward Pre-intermediate/Intermediate course books, Campaign 2 and other supplementary materials.	36
1.3	Advanced English (SLP 3332/3) Intensive Course The purpose of this international course was to provide advanced intensive language training. The course was delivered over the period of 12 weeks and covered all four language skills. It was based on Inside Out Upper-Intermediate coursebook.	24
1.4	Refresher Basic Course This 120-hour non-intensive course provided training in the four language skills at pre-intermediate level. The course was based on Language in Use course book at pre-intermediate level and supplementary materials.	23
1.5	Refresher Intermediate Course This 120-hour non-intensive course was based on Inside Out Intermediate course book, and supplementary materials for developing reading, speaking, listening and writing skills.	7
2. Military English Language Courses		100
2.1	English Communication for NATO This intensive 20-hour course provided familiarization with spoken and written forms of communication in NATO.	21
2.2	English for the Officer Candidate School This 60-hour course focused on developing language skills through military-oriented topics and tasks. It was based on teacher designed materials, adapted materials and Campaign 1, 2, and 3 depending on students' proficiency levels. The course for the advanced class was partially delivered in the virtual classroom.	32
2.3	English for Military Police The intensive 30-hour course was targeted at MP enlisted personnel. It provided basic job-related speaking, listening and writing skills practice. It was based on adapted materials from UNCIVPOL English Course and selected units from English for Law Enforcement, Campaign 2 and At Ease (English for Peacekeeping).	47

3. Specialized language Courses	31
English STANAG 6001 Preparation This non-intensive 30-hour course aims at providing training in STANAG test task familiarization and test-taking strategies. The course is based on in-house, IELTS and CAE preparation materials.	31

II. Testing

Four STANAG 6001 testing cycles were conducted (September 2009, December 2009, March 2010 and June 2010). Internal workshops for introduction of STANAG (Ed.3) were organised with the aim of introducing + levels in official documents and marking. New tasks for all tests in all four skills were written, moderated and piloted. Three new sets of Reading and Listening tasks were written, moderated and piloted.
