Computer-based Multi-level Test To assess proficiency in Listening (L) and Reading (R) across different levels, (1,2,3,4), based on NATO STANAG 6001 descriptors and guidelines.

Test Format 60 questions, 15 per level. Duration Listening: approx. 1h 15'. Audio played only once. Possible changes in the near future. Reading: 2 hrs. Questions Multiple choice with 4 options per question.

PLUS System The CLE uses the STANAG 6001 plus system to provide accurate and standardized scores for language proficiency (see Table below)



ITEMS CREATION AND MODERATION

ITEM CREATION

In collaboration with the Ministry of Defense, the Carabinieri will chair STANAG 6001 item creation in 2025 for all the Italian armed forces.

Deadlines

Strictly enforced to ensure timely delivery. Quality

Stringent requirements are in place to guarantee items fulfill the necessary criteria. **Quantity**

Producing a sufficient number of items to meet testing demands.

Moderation Pipeline

Step 1. Creation & Collection Items are created and gathered from various sources.

Step 2. Moderation Sessions 3-4 sessions per year, 2 linguistic experts per team, working 1 week (Mon-Fri, 8am-5pm). 120 items (L&R) reviewed per session.

Step 3. Piloting Items are approved, modified/improved or discarded based on expert feedback.

Step 4. Database Upload The leading force uploads approved items from all four Armed Forces into the central database.

Building upon existing international collaborations, CLE aims to **further expand its network of partnerships** with other military language centers and similar institutions.
