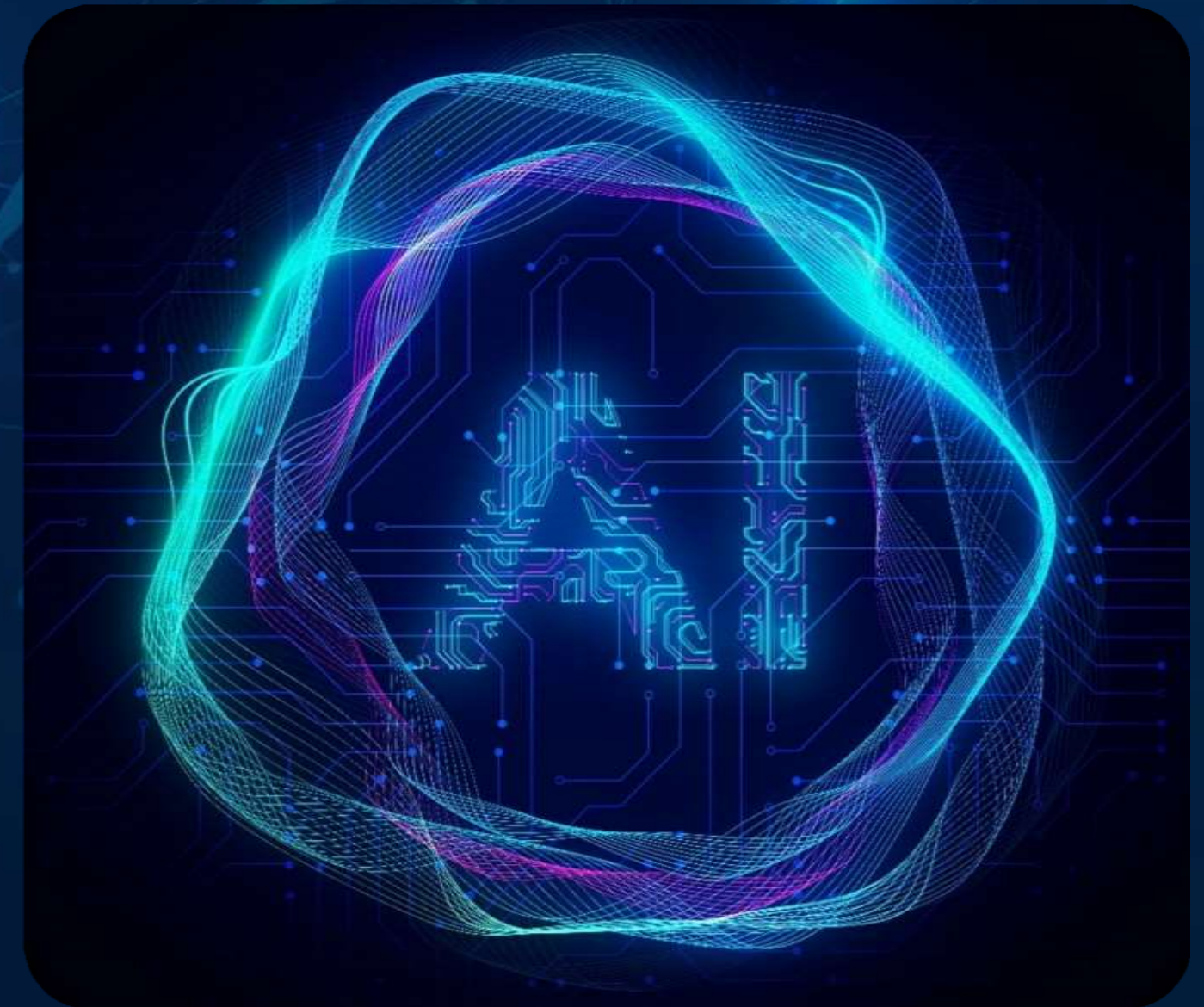
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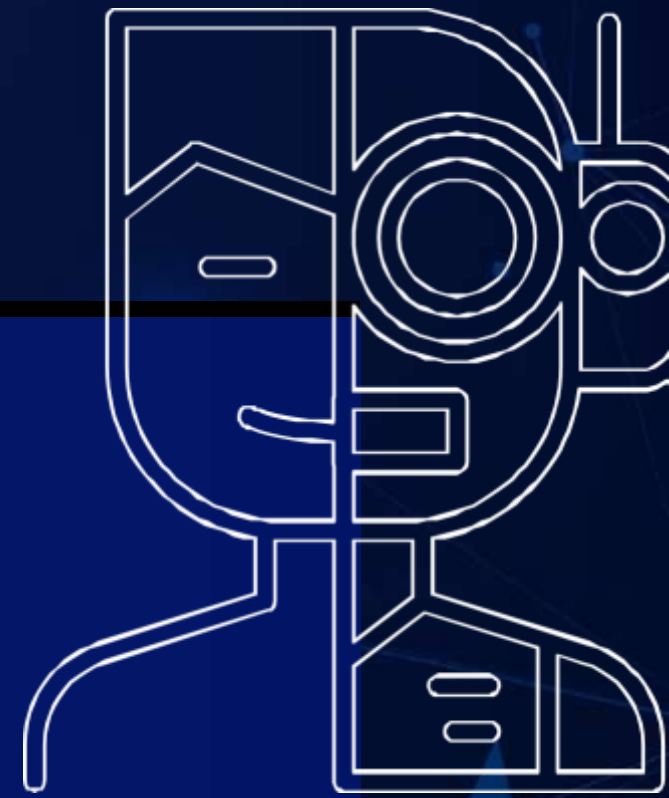

AI TOOLS FOR GRAMMAR LEARNING



Grammar checkers (Grammarly, Microsoft Editor) corrects errors in real time



AI - Powered Writing Assistants suggests better sentence structures



Adaptive learning platforms identify weak areas and focus on practice accordingly

AI tools for vocabulary learning

- 01 Spaced Repetition Systems (SRS)-(Anki, Quizlet with AI) improve long-term memory
- 02 AI Chatbots practice new words in real conversations
- 03 Image and Voice Recognition learn vocabulary through pictures and pronunciation

Future Perspectives



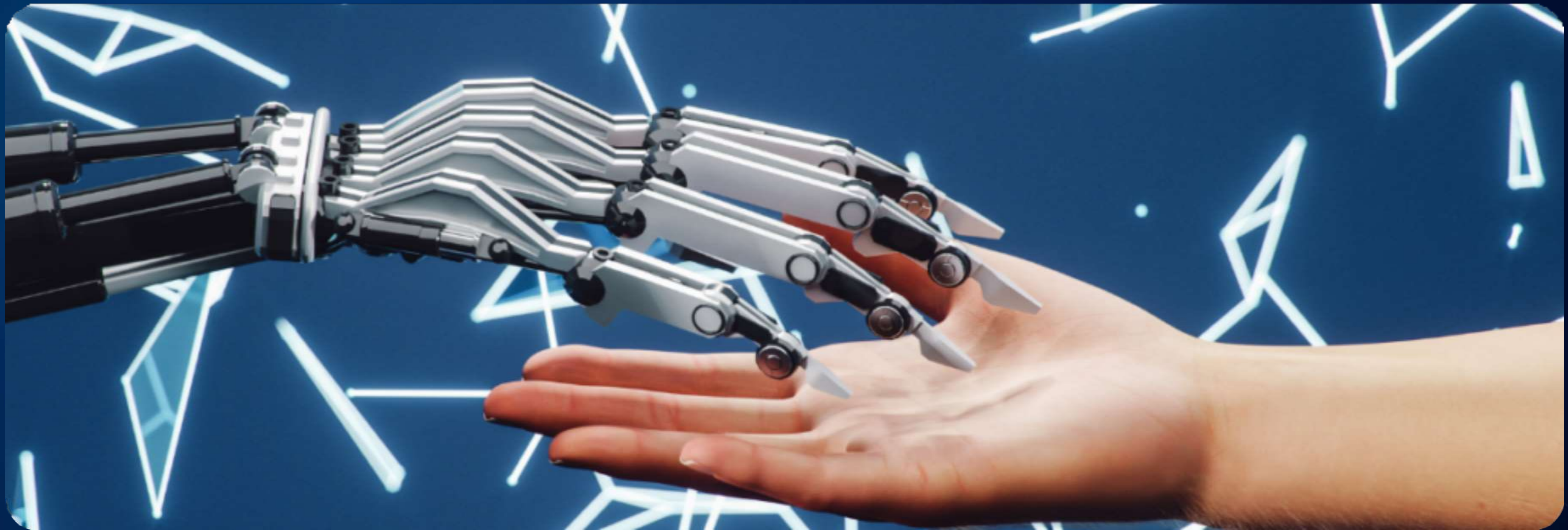
Integration of AI with AR/VR for immersive learning
